Hearing care continuum



Aim

To pilot a standardised reporting tool that

helps audiologists identify potential CI

candidates

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Method

AuditBase Crystal Report run in 5 sites (1 July 2019 - 1 January 2020 at 4; 1 September - 30 November 2019 at 1)

790 adults meeting NICE audiometric criteria retrospectively categorised:


Cl 1 = referred for Cl

CI 2 = not referred, unsuitable/ outside of criteria

CI 3 = not referred, discussed and further assessment needed

CI 4 = not referred, patient declined


CI 5 = No CI discussion documented





British Cochlear Implant Group


CI referral was **not** considered



Cl referral discussed but patient declined









Is age a factor?




- Mean age CI referral NOT considered =
 76 years
- Mean age CI referral WAS considered = 68 years
- No significant difference in age between those who declined CI referral and those who did not



Conclusions


- British Cochlear Implant Group
- CI referral rate and referral decline rate vary across centres
- In up to 50% of cases of severe to profound hearing loss, no documentation that CI referral was considered








Referral breakdown






Referral area







I'm too old for this, but if only I was younger...




I'm too poorly to have the operation

I'm worried about losing my hearing and not been able to go back to my aid








