Will my comments be anonymous?

Yes, we will not record any of your information that could be used to identify you.

Why are my comments important?

The leaflets are generally produced by researchers who are constantly immersed in a scientific setting. This could make it difficult for them to tell if the information present in the leaflets is clear to persons from other backgrounds.

How will my comments be used?

Your anonymous comments will be added to the system database. Then, the system will employ text analytics to recognize parts of new leaflets that are similar to the text that you commented.

Finally, the system will employ the comments in the database to give suggestions to the researcher so he can improve the new leaflet before sending it to the PPI group.
