While I understand the need of using video to be able to see the students' articulation, it still made me uncomfortable to upload a video of myself knowing everyone could see this at any moment and any place.

**3. - What would you change from this task to improve it? Why?**

The deadlines. Because it was confusing at the moment of uploading the first assignment, I personally got confused about it. What a would do is to set a final date to upload both parts of the assignment, but I will required students to upload the first time at least three days before the deadline.

The theme. I think it was very catchy and easy for the students to practice the topic using that theme.
