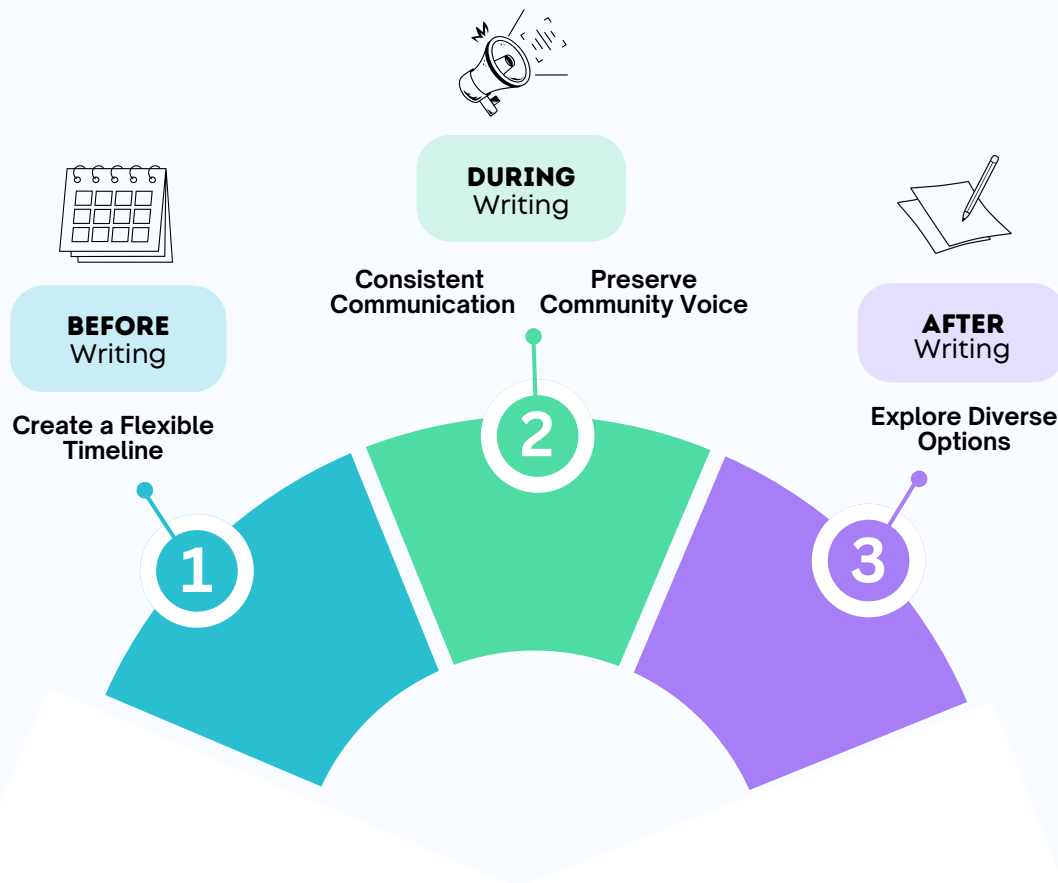

1 Before Writing

Create a Flexible Timeline

Offer a clear but adaptable timeline at the start of the writing process to help manage expectations and structure involvement

2 During Writing

Consistent Communication

Keep co-authors informed about progress, especially during delays

Preserve Community Voice

Prioritise the integrity of community partners' words, reflections and experiences in the writing

3 After Writing

Explore Diverse Options

Consider journals, blogs or magazines that support community co-authorship and accessible writing styles, even if less 'prestigious'.
